We will also:

- Promote awareness of Wellbeing Swanage and other services provided at The
 Focus Centre in Swanage and at Herston Village Hall as well as other health and
 care services provided in Purbeck and other local self-help and support groups
- Work with the PPGs of the other Practices within the Purbeck Primary Care Network (PCN) - and the Purbeck Youth PPG - to support the PCN to deliver its priorities, including the development and implementation of the Purbeck Integrated Neighbourhood Team (INT)
- Support the Practice to deliver initiatives that promote health and wellbeing, prevent ill health and support self-care
- Promote awareness of the Purbeck Youth PPG (YPPG) and its remit, and support efforts to recruit new YPPG members
- Contribute to the work of Action for Health and Care in Purbeck, the Purbeckwide group set up in 2023.
